THE BERNARD BLACKWELL ALL-STAR FOOTBALL CLASSIC

77th ANNUAL ALL-STAR FOOTBALL GAME

Sponsored By *Rex Team Sports*

The December 2025 All-Star Game continues a series that was inaugurated in 1950 by the Mississippi State University Athletic Department at the urging of Arthur (Slick) Morton, then head coach of the Bulldogs. The first two games matched North and South teams led by outstanding college coaches. Bob Woodruff, the head coach at Florida, coached the 1950 Yankees to a 26-6 victory. In the 1951 contest, the South Rebels, coached by Don Faurot of Missouri, marked a 13- 6 victory over the North, coached by the late Charlie Caldwell of Princeton.

Beginning in 1952, the Jackson Touchdown Club, at the invitation of the late C. R. (Dudy) Noble, then Athletic Director at Mississippi State, assumed sponsorship of the All-Star Game, and inaugurated the policy of selecting outstanding Mississippi high school coaches to lead the teams. Showing a keen interest in promoting amateur athletics and the Lacey Hughes Memorial Scholarship Fund, Coca Cola became a joint sponsor in 1985.

In 1989 the most significant change in the game's history took place as the competitive format was altered from a North vs. South battle to "The Mississippi Challenge", which features All-Stars from Class 4A/5A schools versus All-Stars from Class 1A/2A/3A schools. The year 1993 saw the return of the North vs. South format. The most recent changes in the venue of the game is the movement of the game from July to December and changing it's location to the Gulf Coast area from Jackson. These changes went into effect the 2009-2010 school year.

The Hughes Scholarship fund, named in honor of Dr. Lacey Hughes, the first president of the Touchdown Club, is the chief beneficiary of the proceeds from the game. Scholarship awards totaling over \$150,000 have been given from the fund to assist worthy young men and women of Mississippi obtain college educations.

It was November of 1946 when Dr. Hughes and 15 other football enthusiasts gathered to form the Jackson Touchdown Club. Football interest and activity in Mississippi made great strides in the "Fabulous Forties" and the Touchdown Club kept pace. By the finish of the club's first season, its membership had increased and by the 1950's it was established as one of the largest and most prestigious sports organizations in the South. Today the Club numbers over 100 members. Meeting every Monday evening during football season at Primos Northgate, some of the most outstanding speakers in the nation have been featured.

The late Arnold Hederman, then sports editor of *The Clarion Ledger*, served as the club's second president and membership soared. Carl Walters, long time sportswriter and columnist in Jackson for three newspapers- *The Daily News*, *The State Times* and *The Clarion Ledger*, was the major force behind the Touchdown Club taking sponsorship of the All-Star Game. Walters served as chairman of the Team Selection Committee through 1978 and down through the years handled numerous details in addition to editorially boosting the game at every opportunity.

The Jackson Touchdown Club relinquished its rights to the game to the Mississippi Association of Coaches in January 1993.

In 1994 the game was renamed "The Bernard Blackwell All-Star Football Classic" to honor Bernard Blackwell, Executive Secretary of the M.A.C. for 28 years. Coach Blackwell drowned on September 13, 1993 and the coaches of the M.A.C. chose this way to honor him.

Coach Blackwell was a legendary figure in Mississippi coaching history who was one of the founder of the MAC. A native of Saucier, he was a three-sport letterman in football, basketball, and track at Ole Miss from 1944 to 1947. He was a *Times Picayune* All-American football player for the Rebels.

After earning his college degree, he entered the coaching profession in 1948 as a football coach at Northwest Junior College. He coached at West Tallahatchie High from 1950 to 1956, at Greenville High from 1956 to 1958, and at Pascagoula High in 1959.

In 1960, he arrived at Mississippi College in Clinton where he would remain in coaching until he was named as Assistant to the President of Mississippi College in 1972. In 1976, he was selected as National Director of the Mississippi College Alumni Affairs where he served until his retirement in 1993.

During his coaching career, Coach Blackwell was instrumental in creating the Mississippi Association of Coaches in 1954. He helped to shape the association into one of the most innovative and progressive coaching organizations in the United States. He developed the MAC into a professional association and fostered great relations between coaches, their schools, and the community at large.

Among his many achievements with the MAC, Coach Blackwell helped create the MAC Coaches Hall of Fame, which began in 1973. Coach Blackwell even served as emcee for the annual induction banquet for many years after the formation of the MAC Hall of Fame. He paid keen attention to the needs of the coaches and was instrumental in providing invaluable training opportunities with the coaching clinics he arranged.

His attention to details for the association and his desire to enhance the experience and profile of Mississippi high school athletics and their coaches led to his efforts in creating the Mississippi/Alabama All-Star Football Classic in 1988, the Mississippi/Alabama All-Star Basketball Games in 1991, and the annual State Games in Meridian.

For his efforts in leading the MAC as Executive Director through its formative years and beyond, Coach Blackwell received numerous honors. He was awarded the National High School Athletic Coaches Association Dwight Keith Award in 1987 and was bestowed the Mississippi College Order of the Golden Arrow in 1991. Coach Blackwell was inducted into the MAC Coaches Hall of Fame in 1980, the Mississippi College Athletic Hall of Fame in 1991, and posthumously into the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame in 2001.

The Bernard Blackwell All-Star Football Classic is formerly known as the Mississippi High School All-Star Football Game and was originated in 1950 by Mississippi State coach Arthur "Slick" Morton. The Mississippi Association of Coaches assumed sponsorship of the game from the Jackson Touchdown Club in 1993. In 1994, the game was renamed for Coach Bernard "Blacky" Blackwell, the Executive Director of the MAC who served the association from 1962 to 1991 and departed this life in 1993. Through this game, the MAC is proud to continue to honor the name of Coach Bernard "Blacky" Blackwell and the coaching and administrative legacy he passed on to generation of coaches.

BILL STEWART AWARD

The Bill Stewart Award is presented annually as a memorial to Bill Stewart of McComb, an outstanding athlete who was killed in action as a U.S. Marine Corps officer in the Korean Conflict. It is presented "... to the All-Star football player whose attitude, character, and conduct on and off the field best exemplify the life and endeavors of Bill Stewart, athlete, gentleman, and sacrificial patriot."

The Bill Stewart Award was initiated in 1955 by Arthur (Slick) Morton of Greenwood, former head coach at Mississippi State University. J. E (Squatty) Hall of Jackson served as chairman of the award committee from its beginning until his death in 1981.

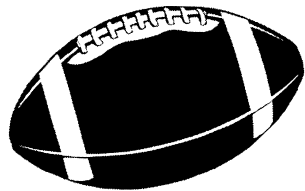
