SUBJECT: Instructions for All-Star Activities March 14-15, 2025

Please read the following instructions carefully; they should furnish all the information you need to help you follow through on your responsibilities.

Reporting Date: Friday, March 14, 2025**Reporting Time:** Coaches: Please report by 3 P.M.

Players will report at the following times:

- 1A/2A/3A/4A Teams: 4 P.M.
- 5A/6A/7A Teams: 5 P.M.
- **Report To:** All-Stars will report to Fairfield Inn & Suites, 105 Hampstead Pl., Clinton, MS.
- What to Bring: All practice apparel--shorts, socks and shoes. Shorts should be athletic shorts.

What NOT ToM.A.C. rules will not permit players to wear earrings during any of theBring:All-Star activities. Therefore, we advise those of you who wear earrings to leave
them at home. Failure to comply with this rule will result in dismissal from the
team.

- Cars: If you bring a car, you will be required to park it in the parking lot at all times, and turn the keys in to your All-Star Coach. Any travel necessary will be provided by the M.A.C.
- **Conduct:** All players will be under the supervision of the All-Star Coaches. You have agreed to follow all the rules of the Mississippi Association of Coaches, and are expected to keep your word.

M.A.C. Board policy states that "should any All-Star Player violate any rule of conduct of the Association, that player will be sent home <u>immediately.</u>"

Physicals:Physical screenings will be administered by medical staff of Mississippi Sports Medicine
& Orthopaedic Center. Your participation depends upon our passing this examination. As
stated in the Player Selection guidelines, female players cannot participate if pregnant.

Game Tickets:	The games will be played Saturday, March 15, in the A. E. Wood Coliseum at Mississippi College in Clinton, MS. The 1A/2A/3A/4A girls' game will begin at 12:00 Noon, followed by the 1A/2A/3A/4A boys' at approximately 1:30 PM; the 5A/6A/7A girls game will begin at approximately 3:00 PM, followed by the 5A/6A/7A boys at approximately 4:30 PM. General admission tickets (good for all games) can be purchased on game day for \$10.00 each as well as through GoFan.
Insurance:	The MAC provides secondary accidental medical insurance. Your parents have already signed a form indicating they understand this procedure.
Meals:	All meals will be provided.
Jerseys:	All-Stars will have the option to purchase their game jersey at the conclusion of their game.
Ad Commission:	<i>Commission checks for All-Stars who sold a minimum of \$350.00</i> in ad sales will be issued to you by your All-Star Coach.
Checking Out:	Before leaving Mississippi College after the game, be sure to have your post- participation physical screening by the <i>Mississippi Sports Medicine</i> trainers.
